





| Reversing<br>Sensors               | These provide a visual and audible warning of proximity to cars, posts, garages etc.  The best of these is a mirror with integrated distance and corner display.   | O.8 M |
| Power Boot<br>Opener               | Electrically powered boot opening is very convenient and much safer for those with mobility challenges.  A wireless keyfob is used to control the opening and closing from a safe distance.                                    |       |
| Automatic<br>Wheelchair<br>Loaders | These deliver the wheelchair from the boot of the car to the driver's door, and vice versa.  This is the ultimate in convenience for wheelchair users, keeping the chair warm and dry, and leaving the car exterior unaltered. |       |
| Visor extender                     | This prevents sun-strike blinding the driver, by providing a tinted extension along the length of the visor.  Slides up when not in use.   |       |

Several styles available.



# Electric Drive Assist for manual wheelchairs

Various types are available, to reduce the joint strain from pushing a wheelchair regularly.

Some are joystick controlled, some auto-maintain a speed manually established.

In combination with an AbiLoader these can for some people be a more suitable and very much less expensive solution than the full electric chair / drive-in van conversion.



# Semi-automatic or Automatic Clutch conversion

If you have a manual vehicle, but have difficulty operating the clutch with your foot, this device operates the clutch by hand from a gear-levermounted trigger.



# Electronic Cursor Accelerator


This is a thumb-actuated accelerator, on a curly cord, which controls the throttle via an electronic control unit.

These can be made to work from a variety of inputs including tiller or other options.


